	Copies of high school and/or college Transcripts (education) or Resume (professional training)

Evaluation and Award

The WID FC Board of Directors will select the recipient(s) by grading and ranking applications for each requirement using the weighted values. Applications will be evaluated separately for education and professional training.

- Each application will be scored by at least 2 WID FC Board Members
- Each requirement will be scored 1-5 with 5 being excellent, and the two scores averaged for each requirement
- Averaged scores for each requirement will be multiplied by its appropriate weighting factor
- The total of the weighted values will be the final score for the application
- **Recipient(s) will be notified** of award(s) on August 30th
- **Awards will be distributed** by check(s) to awardee(s)
